

THE BIBLE IN STORY NUMBER 11—Genesis 41:46-45:28

I. Seven years of plenty—41:46-57

II. Seven years of famine—42:1-45:15.

- A. Jacob sends ten sons into Egypt for grain.
Joseph accuses them of being spies.
He keeps Simeon in prison.
- B. Jacob again sends his sons into Egypt.
Benjamin is accused of stealing Joseph's cup.
Joseph reveals who he is, and sends for Jacob to move to Egypt.

III. Jacob goes into Egypt with his family—45:16-28

- A. God speaks to Jacob.
- B. Jacob prepares for the journey.
- C. He meets Pharaoh.
